Pre-clean by removing any visible soils

AREA	DILUTION	CONTACT TIME <sup>1</sup>	DESCRIPTION <sup>1</sup>
Non-Animal Related Areas (Hallways & Offices)	1:128 (1 oz/gal)	3 Minutes	Non-Food Contact Sanitization
Daily Disinfection of all Animal Housing Areas and Enclosures	1:64 (2 oz/gal)	5 Minutes	Virucide, except for *Canine Parvovirus
		10 Minutes	Bactericide
High Risk/Quarantine Areas	1:32 (4 oz/gal)	10 Minutes	Virucide (including Canine Parvovirus)
Confirmed Disease/Outbreak Conditions	1:16 (8 oz/gal)	5 Minutes	Virucide (including Canine Parvovirus), Bactericide, and Fungicide




Ensure surface remains wet for the required contact time<sup>1</sup>

Allow surface to air dry or wipe dry<sup>2</sup>
